Our recommendations for battery transport

Make sure your shipments are secure

To ensure that the battery is not damaged during transport, we recommend:



- Choose a sturdy box/package per battery and of an appropriate size (not too big, not too small) afin your products are immobilised and not damaged during transport,
- Protect the products you are sending inside the parcel by surrounding them with bubble wrap, polystyrene flocons, air cushions, afin to help immobilise the products,
- · Separate the products one by one and seal the package with adhesive tape.
- Tape the key to the battery (do not insert it into the lock to prevent it from twisting during transport),
- · If the battery is found to be leaking lithium, to have caught fire or to have been dropped violently, it cannot be transported.
- The battery must not be sent with the case open.



SECURITY

Batteries are sensitive products that need to be handled with care and safety. We can provide you with suitable boxes for shipping them.

WELL-BEING

For the well-being of our drivers and teams, the battery must be able to withstand journeys in all conditions.
